The school office hours are 7:30 am – 3:45 pm; with the exception of weekends and holidays.

2012-2013 TK – 8th grade applications will be available in the school office beginning Jan. 30, 2012.

All applications will be processed on a first-come-first-served basis, according to priority. When applying for enrollment, the following items need to be presented with the student application to the school office personnel:

- TK - Eighth Grade applicants: Birth Certificate - (please bring original)
- TK - Eighth Grade applicants: Immunization Records - (please bring original)
- TK - Eighth Grade applicants: Sacrament Certificate(s) - (If applicable)
- Second - Eighth Grade applicants: Additionally - the last two years of academic records (Original Documents - Report Cards and last two years of Standardized Test Scores (when applicable).
- First grade applicants: Additionally - the most recent Kindergarten report card
- TK and Kinder applicants: Unless the class becomes full, prior to the acceptance of an application, a \$320.00 enrollment fee must accompany each TK and Kindergarten application. The fee will be applied to the 2012-13 *non-refundable registration fee.

*If there is not enough space available in the TK or Kinder classes, parents will be notified and the fee will be refunded. The student's application will remain in a waiting file that also matches the respective grade's waiting list.

TK applicants must be 5 years old by December 2, 2012. The Transitional Kindergarten is a two year Kindergarten program and perfect for those students (summer or fall birthdays) who are ready to transition from a pre-school setting. The TK program focuses on speaking and listening, letter and sound recognition, counting and number concepts, religion, and social development. TK class sessions operate Monday—Friday from 8 – 11 a.m. The TK program shadows the St. Rose School calendar, policies, and guidelines. St. Rose School uniforms are not required for TK students. TK students have the opportunity to use the services of the St. Rose School Extended Day Program at an additional cost.

DK applicants must be 5 years old by March 1, 2013. Developmental Kindergarten applicants are those children who turn 5 years old after December 2, 2011 and before March 1, 2012. Providing there is space available in the TK class, DK applicants are able to join the Transitional Kindergarten class (already in progress) the month that they turn 5 years old. Please see the TK program description above.

Kinder applicants must be 5 years old by September 1, 2012. St. Rose School Kindergarten offers two sessions: 8-11 am and 12-3 pm, Monday - Friday. An identical curriculum is taught by an experienced teacher with the assistance of an aide to both sessions. The Kindergarten academic curriculum follows the California State Standards and covers each core subject area. It is our goal to reach and exceed the focus of the Standards. In addition, the spiritual growth of the child is met through our Catholic faith-based religion program. The Kinder class follows the St. Rose School calendar, policies, and guidelines. St. Rose School uniforms are required for Kinder students. Kindergarten students have the opportunity to use the after-school services of the St. Rose School Extended Day Program at an additional cost.

First – Eighth grade applicants will be given an interview appointment with the principal, once space availability has been established. Parents will be notified as soon as possible if there is a space available for their child/ren in the 2012-13 classes. The non-refundable registration fee will be expected after the family has met with the principal and enrollment has been confirmed.

Wednesday, Feb. 8, 2012 ~ Priority for a Participating St. Rose of Lima parishioner [A Participating Parishioner of St. Rose of Lima Parish is identified as a member who: (a) Is a registered parishioner (b) Gives of time and talent through various ministries (c) Using parish envelopes or automatic withdrawal for contributions.]

Thursday, Feb. 9, 2012 ~ Priority for Catholic School Transfers from outside the Sacramento Area (who plan on becoming St. Rose of Lima parishioners)

Monday, Feb. 13, 2012 ~ Priority for Students from surrounding Catholic parishes (such as St. Clare in West Roseville, Sts. Peter & Paul in Rocklin, St. Joseph Morello in Granite Bay, and St. Joseph in Lincoln) **which do not have a Catholic School**

Tuesday, Feb. 14, 2012 ~ Priority for Transfers from another Catholic School in the Sacramento Area

Tuesday, Feb. 21, 2012 ~ No priority needed - Open application period – accepting all applications

Parents will be notified as soon as possible if there is space available for their child/ren in the 2012-2013 classes. If any contact information changes from the time the application has been completed, please notify St. Rose School so we can reach you of an opening for enrollment.
