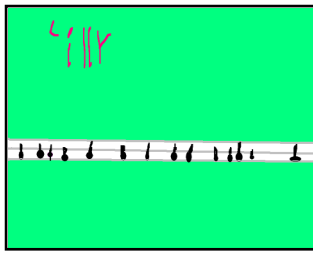

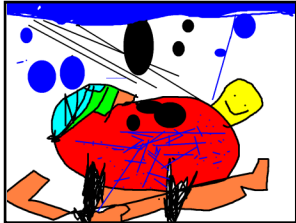
## Music Minute

Polar bears are very dangerous. They live in the Arctic. They like to eat seals and fish. Their fur is white, but their skin is black.

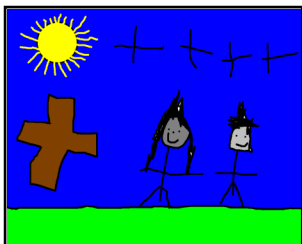


## Prayers

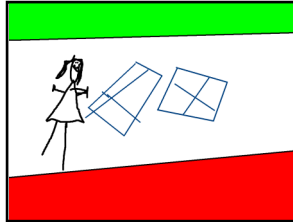
By Breanna

then God said: "Jesus, Jesus. This is my Son." And then there was a special light and that light was God.

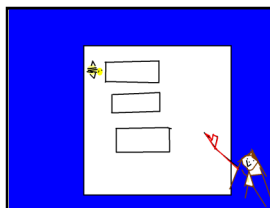


## Math Windows

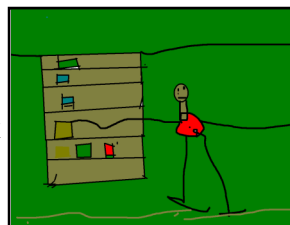


## Bee Rules

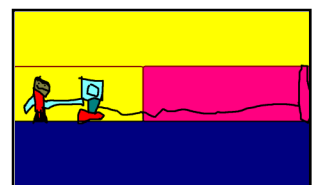
## Sight Words
