Button, Button, Who Has the Button

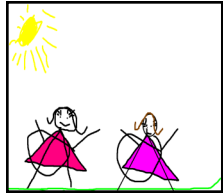

Hula-hoop in P.E.

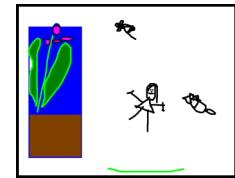

By Makayla

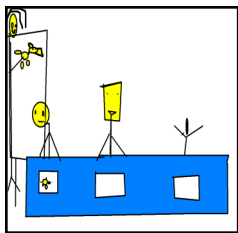

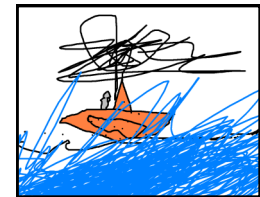

Today we learned about the "Old Lady that Swallowed the Fly". We got to use watercolors over the crayon but the crayon pushed the watercolors back.



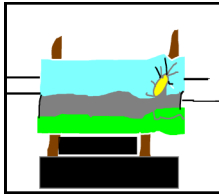
My Father Sailed the Seven Seas

Praying in a Circle

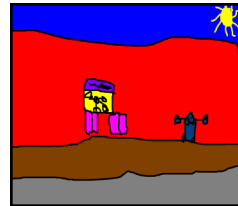

By Justin

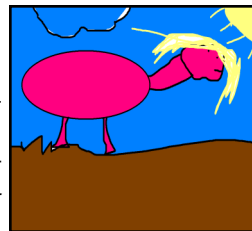


We already read the whole book about Elmer and the dragon. My favorite part of the book was when the father went on the dragon's back and they flew to Wild Island.

By Shawn

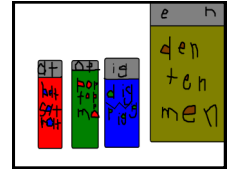
We were supposed to draw a pig in a wig at Computer Center on Wednesday.

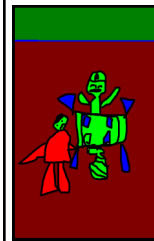
The Writing Center

I like to go to the Writing Center to get all of my "must-do's" done and that is one of the "must-do's". We use these words to spell. This is how we read.

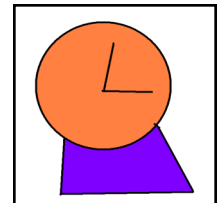
Working at the Game Center
