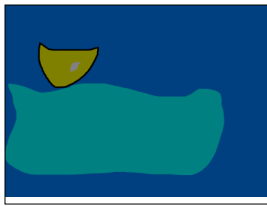

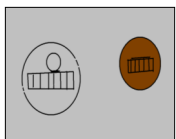
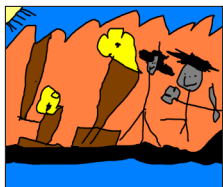
By doing your homework, you get to go to the treasure box. You have to turn in your homework by Fridays.

By Zachary

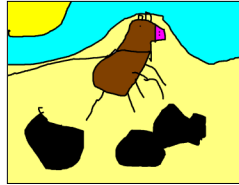
This is money – nickels and pennies. Sometimes we sort

A Visit to the Garden

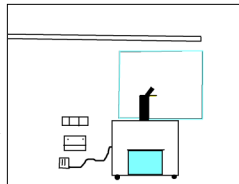

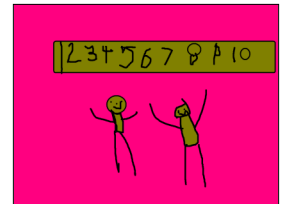
