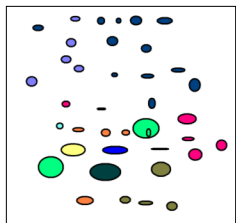

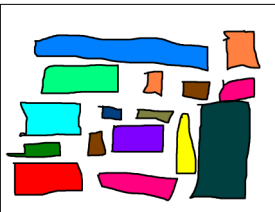
Money

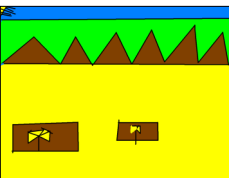
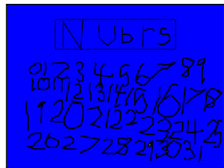

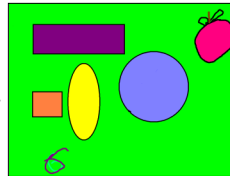
Me and Mrs. Demichei - we went to the strawberry plant. Some were red and some was white and some was small. The peas are one hand tall.
